RELEASE OF

10 YEAR REVIEW OF THE NDP



The National Planning Commission (NPC), in its capacity as an independent advisory body and custodian of the National Development Plan (NDP): Vision 2030 has completed a detailed and thorough ten-year review of the progress made since the adoption of the NDP in 2012.

The review assesses the key NDP indicators or targets, such as poverty, inequality, and unemployment for the past ten years (i.e., 2012-2022). The assessment is timely given that 2024 will mark the end of term for both the sixth administration since South Africa's democratic dispensation, and the current 2019-2024 cycle of the Medium-Term Strategic Framework (MTSF), which guides the work of all government entities.

Alongside the Review, the NPC will issue an urgent Call to Action to reassert the significance of the goals of the NDP as the lodestar of our developmental vision as a nation, rooted in good governance, economic transformation, social cohesion, and a just transition to more sustainable development pathways.
