Water security has always been an issue of concern in South Africa but, in recent times, it is increasingly under very serious threat in the country. The National Water Security Framework (NWSF) responds to the question of the extent of this threat and the actions required in the short, medium and long term to mitigate or offset the threat. It frames a national pathway to a water secure country up to 2050 to enable inclusive economic growth, poverty eradication and reducing inequality, in line with the National Development Plan (NDP) imperatives.

The dialogue is part of the National Planning Commission's (NPC) campaign to communicate and engage with key stakeholders on the work that the commission has done in the past five years to inform improved implementation of the NDP. The purpose of this engagement will be to highlight the challenges and recommendations identified by in the NWSF and identify opportunities for improvement in order to ensure that we catch up and ensure that the commitment we made to be in a better state by 2030 still occurs, at least to an extent that water security becomes part of enabling us to get there.
