7 April 2022 - The third National Planning Commission (NPC) held its first lekgotla on 17-18 March following its five-year appointment by President Cyril Ramaphosa in December 2021. The NPC is an independent advisory body and think-tank established through the revised *Green Paper: National Planning Commission of 2010.* During the lekgotla, the NPC considered its strategic plan, priorities and the actions required to facilitate the implementation of the National Development Plan (NDP).
