The two commissions committed to working with and advising government in addressing the scourge of corruption, lack of capacity, resource constraints, energy insecurity, the growing polarisation between social partners as well as the diminishing levels of trust between citizens and government.

The meeting resolved to work together in mobilising resources and expertise from local and international partners and stakeholders to ramp up the capacity of public institutions, including local government, to respond to the immediate challenges.
